



Use These Techniques to Create "Surprises" when Painting with Spectra® Deluxe Art Tissue™



#1 Wet art tissue with "glue water" and it sticks to the paper, becomes translucent, and releases its color.

#2 Layer one color of art tissue over another and wet it, watch the colors blend and bleed together.

#3 Cut or tear a shape, wet it carefully, and lift it up. Surprise! The art tissue is gone but the shape remains.

#4 Draw with an oil pastel, paint over it with art tissue, remove tissue and the oil pastel pops out of the watery color. This is called a "Resist".

#5 Draw your design on the art tissue with oil pastels, place the drawing face down onto your paper, wet the tissue and remove it. The oil pastel blocks the color from transferring onto your design. This is called a "Reverse Resist".

#6 Wrap a small piece of Spectra® Deluxe Art Tissue™ around your brush, dip the brush into the water and paint with it. Watch the color flow onto the paper with delicate precision.
